The State Board of Elections is providing the following guidance in relation to processing absentee ballot applications for the June 23, 2020 primary and special election: Executive Order 202.23, issued on April 24, 2020, requires County Boards of Elections to mail absentee ballot applications to all eligible active and inactive voters.

### Executive Orders COVID19 | New York State Board of Elections

Voters must sign an affidavit at their polling place that states their absentee ballot was lost, destroyed or never arrived. Voters who request an absentee ballot aren't required to vote by mail.
