### Allen Cognitive Level Screen Assessment

The Allen Cognitive Levels scale or ACL Scale (Allen & Blue, 1998) was developed in the late 1960's by Allen and colleagues through systematic observation and documentation of predictable patterns of performance of adults in inpatient mental health settings as they engaged in activities of daily living (ADLs), instrumental activities of daily living (IADLs) and leisure activities.

### Allen Scale - Allen Cognitive Level Screen Assessment

Claudia Allen, the developer of this system, divided the levels into several sub-levels, the so-called cognitive modes of performance. The modes (4.4, 5.2, etc.) serve the purpose of characterizing a person's cognitive functioning more specifically. There are five of them in each level, except ACL 6, so the Allen Cognitive Levels include 26 points.

### Allen Cognitive Levels Chart and Description

Scores correspond with the levels of care the person may need. Their range in this Allen cognitive test is from 3.0 (the lowest score) to 5.8 (the highest score). But assessing a person's cognitive function is just an initial step. The next step is accurate interpretation of the scoring.

Allen Cognitive Levels and Dementia The results of the test are assessed on the basis of the cognitive levels, also developed by Claudia K. Allen. The scale from zero to six refers to different abilities and, accordingly, lists specific care and supervision needed in daily life.

### Use of the Allen's Cognitive Test for Identifying Dementia

The Allen Cognitive Level Screen (ACLS) is part of a body of assessment tools and references that comprise the Allen Battery. The screening tools are designed to provide an initial estimate of cognitive function. The score from the screen must be validated by further observations of performance.

## **Allen Cognitive Level Scale: Theory and Assessment ...**

The Allen Cognitive Level (ACL) Leather Lacing Test (Allen, 1985) was developed to differentiate between the levels. The lowest levels, level one (automatic actions) and level two (postural actions), reflect very low levels of functioning and are rarely encountered in acute care inpatient psychiatric settings.
