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Ampere is the electrical unit of electrical current. It measures the amount of electrical charge that flows in an electrical circuit per 1 second. 1A = 1C / 1s. Ohm (Ω) Ohm is the electrical unit of resistance. $1\Omega = 1V / 1A$. Watt (W) Watt is the electrical unit of electric power. It measures the rate of consumed energy. $1W = 1J / 1s$. $1W = 1V \cdot 1A$
