Three major approaches to social capital exist in the social science literature. The most dominant is the functional approach, as represented in the work of political scientist Robert Putnam. For Putnam (1993: 167) social capital consists of “features of social organization, such as trust, norms, and networks, that can improve the efficiency of society by facilitating coordinated action.”.

Coleman (1988:S100) defined social capital as capital inherent in “the relations among persons,” which is separable from other forms of resources such as financial capital (e.g., income) and human capital (e.g., years of schooling). Following this notion, earlier studies focused mainly on social capital available in the family but subsequent studies expanded social capital views of educational attainment to school environments.
